

### Discussion backdrop

- Climate change threatens all aspects of society and natural environments
- Minimizing impacts require an "all in" GHG reductions approach + adaptation
- Hawaii's Act 15 (2018): Net negative GHG emissions goal by 2045
- Hawaii is a small GHG emitter relative to global scale
- On a per capita basis, Hawaii residents emit more than 2x global average
- Role of carbon taxes, credits and offsets to reduce emissions and address climate change adaptation
